

Bundanon Work Readiness Program

Hospitality / tourism roles in an Art and Cultural space. Training and work experience.



The Shoalhaven Youth into Work Initiative are working with the Bundanon Trust to prepare people for exciting roles at the Art Museum on the banks of the Shoalhaven River at Illaroo.

The Riversdale Masterplan Project will include an art museum, creative learning centre, visitor information centre, accommodation and café with a planned opening in November 2021.

The Bundanon work readiness program will include training in hospitality, customer service, tourism and housekeeping, plus work experience to prepare people for exciting roles at the Riversdale Masterplan Project on the Shoalhaven River. These roles will include Museum Guides, Operations Assistants and Accommodation Support opportunities.

1 days work experience and a site visit to Bundanon after the training has completed with employment opportunities available.

To be eligible for the program:

- Eligible for smart and skilled funding including full Australian work rights
- Capacity to undertake the skill set in regards numeracy and literacy.

Formal training will be delivered at TAFE and include the following units:

- Deliver a service to customers
- Deliver and monitor a service to customers
- Provide responsible service of alcohol
- Provide visitor information
- Provide housekeeping services to guests
- Cultural sensitivity.
